Our goal is to provide young men the opportunity to enhance their basketball skills and understand the importance of competing. Through drill work and actual games each camper will learn and look forward to what the next day brings. This will lead each camper into their upcoming season with a better overall understanding of the game of basketball.

CAMP DIRECTOR



Mike Fuline finished his second season as head men's basketball coach at Mount Union where he guided the Purple Raiders to the OAC Tournament Championship for only the fourth time in school history. Before coming to Mount Union, he spent eight years as a head coach at Massillon Jackson (2005-11) and Rootstown (2003-05) and high schools.

He was 95-42 (.693) in six years at Jackson, with a 76-19 (.800) mark over the last four seasons that also included winning the 2010 OHSAA Division I State championship. The Polar Bears have won each of the last two Federal League titles and he was named Federal League Coach of the Year both seasons.

At Rootstown, his 2003-04 team posted a 16-6 record and won a sectional championship while his 2004-05 team went 20-4, shared the league title and won a district championship. Fuline was named 2004 Ohio's Division III Co-Coach of the Year.

Fuline began his coaching career with assistant coaching stints at Ravenna and Green high schools.
